Who we are?

- We are a collaborative platform born in 2023 that connects popular and solidarity economy organisations, academia, NGOs, and institutions to develop initiatives in marketing, training, research, management, and advocacy in southwestern Colombia. Currently, we are 14 grassroots organisations, 3 institutional allies, with over 150 participating families across 6 municipalities in the Nariño and Putumayo departments, working on agroecological transition and solidarity economy processes, united in a collective effort for life.
