1,000 **Cultivated area of 614 hectares**, equivalent to almost **1,000 football fields**

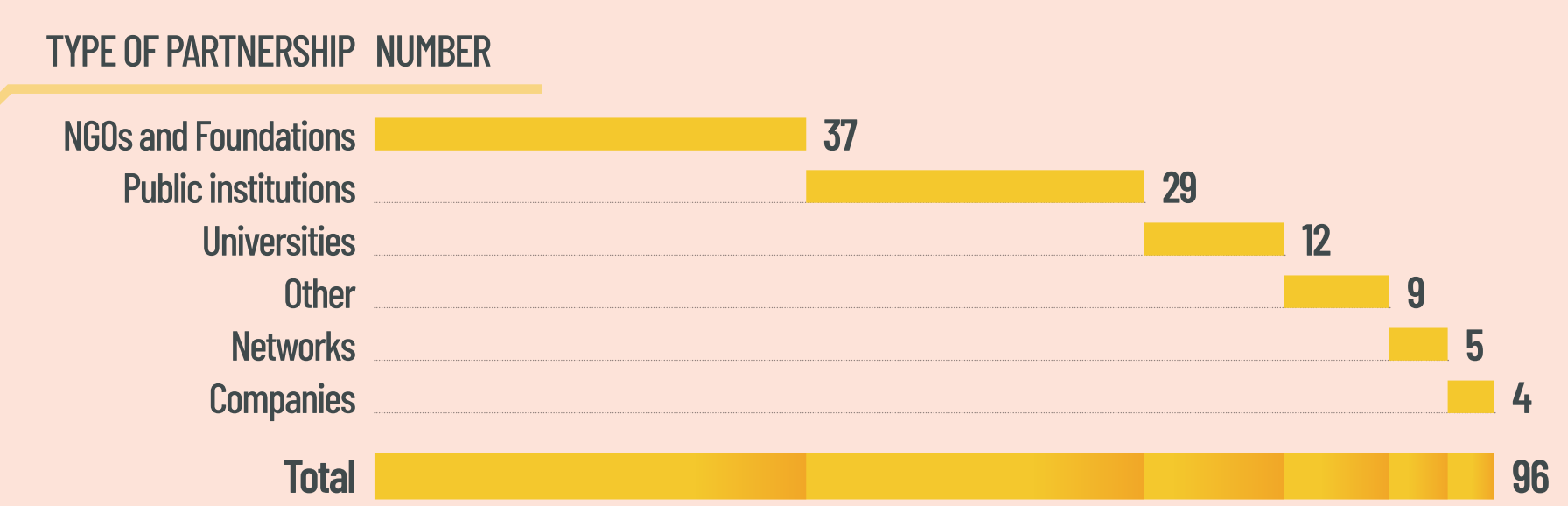
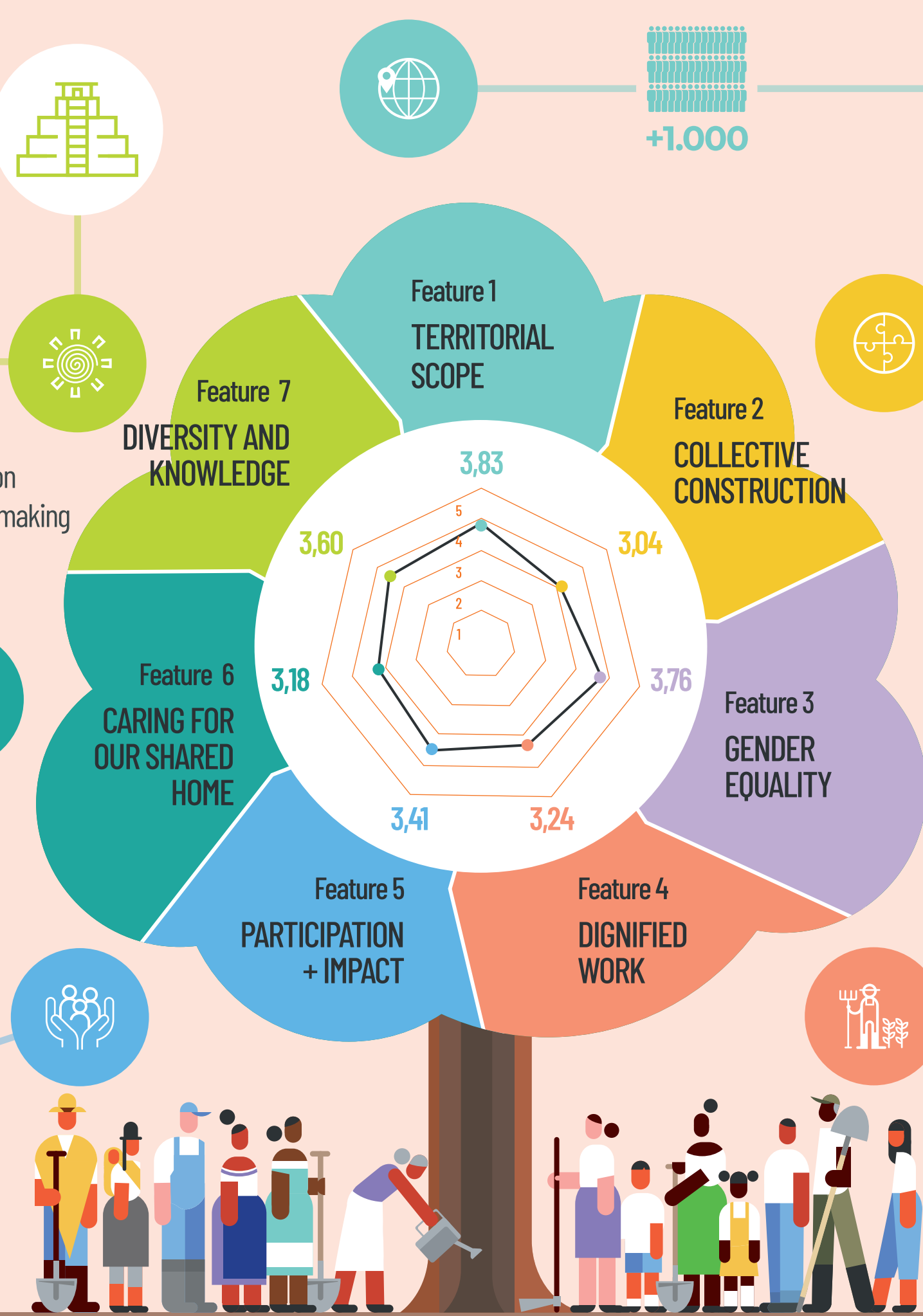
30% of purchases are of **organic or local origin**
